The conference will be hosted in Brisbane, the capital city of the State of Queensland and the third largest city in Australia by population and geographic area. December in Brisbane is warm and pleasant with average maximum and minimum daily temperatures of 29° and 21°. Brisbane is well connected internationally with direct flights from Sydney, Melbourne, Adelaide, Hobart, and Perth, as well West Coast US and most Asian air transit hubs. Brisbane is also a short 1.5 hour flight from Sydney, and 2 hour flight from several regional towns near the world heritage listed Great Barrier Reef. In addition to this, it is a short 1.5 hour drive to the amazing beaches of the Sunshine Coast and the Gold Coast.

The venue for the conference is the Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre (BCEC). The BCEC is located on Brisbane's Southbank, the city's premier lifestyle and cultural precinct a short walk or ferry ride across the Brisbane river from the CBD. Accommodation is plentiful, with dozens of options ranging from backpacker hostels to 5 star hotels within walking distance of the conference venue.

Facing an impending tsunami of digital and technological disruptions in the next decade, engineers will need to lead, adapt and be agile in response. Thus, it is proposed that the conference theme seek to answer how engineering researchers and educators will play a part in navigating these new frontiers in education. The conference theme is:
