MANUSCRIPT FORMAT

Do not exceed 6 single-space double column, 8.5 x 11-inch pages (including figures, tables and references) in 11 point Times New Roman or similar font. Number each page. Include an abstract, five to ten keywords, and the corresponding author's e-mail address. Submissions should represent original, substantive research results. We will not accept any paper which, at the time of submission, is under review for or has already been published (or accepted) for publication in another conference or journal.

SUBMISSION DETAILS

Submitted papers will be carefully evaluated based on originality, significance, technical soundness, and clarity of exposition. All papers will be refereed by at least two members of the program committee. All submitted papers MUST be formatted according to the author guidelines provided by IEEE Computer Society Press which can be found at Manuscript Template web page. It must be no longer than 6 pages and no less than 3 pages in length.
