- The future of AI in electronic commerce: This theme can explore emerging trends, challenges, and opportunities in the integration of AI with electronic commerce. It can discuss cutting-edge technologies, such as natural language processing, computer vision, and predictive analytics, and their potential to shape the future of commerce.

Selected papers from ICEC 2024 may be invited to contribute to special issues(https://www.icec.net/specialissues2024) of journals such as Decision Support Systems (SCIE, Elsevier), Data Science and Management (Scopus, Elsevier), and Journal of Information Technology Service (KCI).
