Submission Guidelines

Your extended abstract should ideally give an overview of your work, briefly highlighting the main idea and the key results, perhaps with an essential figure(s). It should help conference attendees get the gist of the paper before they attend your talk/poster.

The extended abstract is strictly limited to **two pages**. The standard IEEE format may be used for preparing the extended abstract.

Original and completed results will be considered for oral presentation. Early research work will be considered for poster presentation. Students are encouraged to send their early work for poster sessions. Acceptance notification will indicate whether the paper will be presented in SCS or SCW but also the type of presentation is oral or poster.

Further, the title, author's name(s) and a 500 word abstract of the paper **accepted for SCS** must appear on IEEJ site by February 1, 2021. They must also upload the final manuscript on IEEJ website before March 1, 2021. The final manuscripts must be limited to 6 pages and prepared using the IEEJ format (available on IEEJ site).
