The papers should be based on original work that should typically include a clear description of the problem being addressed, overview of and comparison to related work, the theoretical framework/model proposed by the authors, experimental results, and conclusions. Papers will be reviewed by a review committee which will ensure that only quality papers with originality and novelty are accepted for presentation in the symposium.

Submission Guidelines

- Papers should be a maximum of 8 pages and must be prepared in IEEE double column format
- Maximum 3 authors per paper are allowed.

- All the accepted and presented papers of the duly registered authors will be published in International Journal of Computer Applications and the best paper will be duly awarded.
