Category B

(Preliminary/Work in Progress Papers - 4-6 single column pages)

Category C

(Industry Contributions – abstract only)

This category of papers will be for presentation only. Industry practitioners are particularly encouraged to contribute evidence of challenges encountered in practical asset management situations.
