How to reach Dibrugarh University

Dibrugarh University is well-connected by air, train, and road. The nearest airport is Dr. Bhupen Hazarika Airport (IATA: DIB, ICAO: VEMN), located approximately 20 km from the University campus, which receives daily flights from major cities like Delhi, Kolkata, and Guwahati.
